

# Cincinnati Track & Field – All-Time Top 25 – Boys

## Introduction

The following lists recognize the top ten (25) performers who have been student athletes at a Cincinnati-area based high school at the time of their listed performance.

## Purpose

To give recognition to the best performers that Cincinnati high schools have produced during an approximate century of high school track and field.

## Guidelines for Inclusion in the Top 25 Lists

In order to properly identify those individuals meeting criteria necessary for inclusion, it was necessary to develop an acceptable set of standards that would allow for proper categorization of performances of the past, present, and future in as much as is possible. In doing so, it has been agreed that identifying such performances should conform as much as possible with standards recognized by the NFHS, USATF, IAAF, and ATFS. In addition, it was necessary to identify those athletes that were eligible for inclusion based on these standards. The following criteria have been identified as defining that necessary for inclusion.

### Membership Eligibility

- The school must have competed in a Cincinnati area district meet for the majority of its duration. Given that the current format district meet has been around since 1965, criteria for inclusion prior to 1965 is for that school to have competed in either the old Cincinnati or Oxford District meets that led directly to the State meet for the majority of the period 1925-1965.
- The athlete must have competed for a recognized OHSAA scholastic team during the season said a mark was made.
- The athlete must not have entered college prior to the date of said performance.
- Relay team members must all be from the same high school team.
- Marks are allowable throughout the calendar year. However, in the case of seniors, the cut-off date for inclusion is August 31 of their senior year, so long as they have not entered college to that date.

### Performance Eligibility for Top 25

- **All** marks **must** be documented. That is, there must be evidence of the mark, the meet/site it was made at, and as near as can be ascertained, the date of the performance. Documentation can be meet results available at the meet or on the web, results in the newspapers, or some other form of official documentation (meet records listed in meet programs, etc.).
- **Not** acceptable for inclusion are listings of school records on school websites or some coach's or people's memories **unless** supported by other documentation of said performance. Too many school websites have been shown to contain errant data, and people's memories fade with time or misremember an occurrence. While these can help point statisticians towards other documentation that can support such information, they are not substantial enough to be called factual.
- FAT performances **only** are eligible for races up through the 400m. Those races included are:
  - 100m, 200m, 400m, 100mH, 110mH, 300mH, and the 4x100m.
  - MT marks are kept on separate lists. A select few have been presented herein where a standard 0.24 conversion factor added to the MT mark would yield a time that would make the top 10 list. However, MT marks are **not** eligible for inclusion with FAT marks in the top 10 lists.
- MT performances **are allowable** for inclusion for distances greater than 400m. However, in the case of an FAT mark and an MT mark having the same tenths digit, the FAT mark will take precedence in the lists due to accuracy of timing.
- No intermediate or en-route times (to a longer distance) are eligible for list inclusion at any distance, regardless of whether there was an official FAT measurement or not at the shorter distance.

- Yards vs. Meters – *No* conversions are made to marks made over imperial distances in order to approximate an equivalent metric distance mark. While making such a conversion is commonly done for comparison purposes and has a great deal of validity in a general sense, such conversions were decided against for purposes of these lists. This is due to the inherent fact that no one can *accurately* determine what that mark would be given differing rates of “closing” speed at the end of a given race. As the race becomes longer, the difference between “equivalent” yards and metric races become greater, and the margin of error becomes greater in approximating such a difference between the two.
- Wind Legal Marks are REQUIRED for the: 100m / 200m / 110mH / Long Jump
  - 100m / 200m / 110mH - These events require having wind legal readings (wind  $\leq$  +2.0 meters per second (mps)) or to have come from meets where a wind gauge was used for the performance *and* the mark was recognized as a wind-legal mark, despite the lack of an actual wind reading printed in the results.
    - Note: Until the last 10 years, such information was commonly not printed in the results. However, the state and regional championships, along with some nationally known meets, did include anemometers at the event site for years going back into the 1970’s, but didn’t print such information in the results. However, most did print a “w” to follow the event results where an illegal wind was aiding the runners. Those races that had such a “w” after the winner’s name automatically disqualify any of the athletes in that race from inclusion on the lists, including the winner.
  - Long Jump - Given that many performances of the past *may* have been wind legal marks (wind gauge required, again) except for the lack of such information printed in meet results, those performances have been categorized into a separate list where those marks exceed the #10 performance of the top-10 list. If wind readings from those particular marks becomes know and supports a wind-legal performance, then those marks will be moved into the wind-legal list and be included in the top-10 list if such is the case.
- Relay Teams – Each relay team listed has at least one member that is different from another team.
  - Note: Many teams consisting of the same four relay team members have multiple performances that are superior to other teams on the list. However, the purpose of these lists are to list the top 10 individual teams. Performance lists are kept separately.

## List Notations

- All listed times were run in finals unless otherwise noted. For those performances that were not set in finals, the round (heat, quarter-final, semi-final, etc.) is noted after the listed meet.
- All times are FAT unless otherwise denoted with an “MT” following the performance.
- All field event results are shown as imperial marks (feet, inches). Those marks made at meets with metric only measurements are converted to imperial using the **Big Gold Book** (*Track & Field News*). The original metric mark is kept in a separate database for future reference in case of an apparent “tie” between imperial marks should such an occasion occur.
- Where known, wind readings are presented for those key events requiring such for inclusion. If an actual wind reading is not known, an “nwi” follows the mark to indicate the lack of wind information.
- Additional notes of interest
- Downward sloping landing areas – Some facilities have been positively identified as having landing areas for the throws that are downward sloping that clearly exceed regulations just from a visual perspective. Those marks that were made at such a facility have been denoted with an “s” after the respective mark.
